Sub: Issue of Ration Cards to all eligible applicants living in remote areas.

Madam/Sir,

This is in continuation of letter No. 192/FC dt. 22.01.2019 on the above subject. Though the information sought for indicating the position at the end of January, 2019 was to be submitted by 15.02.2019, all of you could furnish such information by 27.03.2019 only. Maximum delay was caused by Gajapati District. Such undue delay must be avoided in future particularly on the issues relate to 119 TSP Blocks. The information received from all of you has been compiled and enclosed herewith for your ready reference.

2. It is evident from the inputs received from you that during the months from October, 2018 to January, 2019 as many as 41,420 new applications were received of which 5,477 were pending at the end of January, 2019. It is a matter of concern that as many as 5,337 households were enlisted in the draft FPL which means that the applicants are entitled to get new ration cards but the concerned BDOs were unable to assist them for want of vacancies/ allocations. In precise, the receipt of new applications, number of cases pending at the end of January, 2019 and the number of households enlisted in the draft FPL have gone up substantially. In view of these facts, it is presumed that pursuant to the earlier instructions, the Marketing Inspectors and the Panchayat Executive Officers have completed their door to door survey to identify the left out households, collected applications for new Ration Card in the prescribed format and submitted all such applications to concerned BDOs for taking suitable decision. Be that as it may, joint statements signed by Marketing Inspectors and Panchayat Executive Officers should be obtained and preserved in the RCMS Centre (at Block headquarters) for future reference. In case it is discovered at a later stage that applications in the prescribed format have not been obtained from some poor households,

the concerned Marketing Inspector/ PEO should be taken to task for their mis-conduct.

3. Basing on the inputs made available for the period ending January, 2019 it is evident that there are more problems in the following 18 Blocks in different Districts:

7 Blocks of Malkangiri District, Muniguda Block of Rayagada District, Lanjigarh Block of Kalahandi District, Kuanrmunda Block of Sundargarh District, Bandhugaon Block of Koraput District, Gumma & Rayagada Blocks of Gajapati District and 5 Blocks (Banspal, Champua, Ghatagaon, Keonjhar and Saharpada) of Keonjhar District. Therefore, these 18 BDOs should be categorically directed to dispose of all pending applications and enlist all the eligible households in the FPL instead of keeping them in the list of draft FPL for an indefinite period.

4. It is also disappointing to note that in these 119 TSP Blocks as many as 29,705 households are yet to receive printed ration cards a despite series of instructions in this regard. Bulk of the problems relate to the 7 Blocks of Malkangiri District. In case printed ration cards have not been made available by the Food Supplies & Consumer Welfare Department till date, you should move the Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Food Supplies & Consumer Welfare Department urgently under intimation to this Commission.

5. In view of the foregoing, it is expected that more serious efforts have been made to dispose of all pending matters by now. However, the status as on 31.03.2019 relating to the TSP Blocks be reported to this Commission in the format enclosed herewith latest by 15.04.2019. In case the desired inputs are not made available relating to any block, the concerned BDO shall be called upon to appear in person to explain his/her mis-conduct/negligence in performing such duties. The format in which relevant information is sought for is at Annexure-A.
