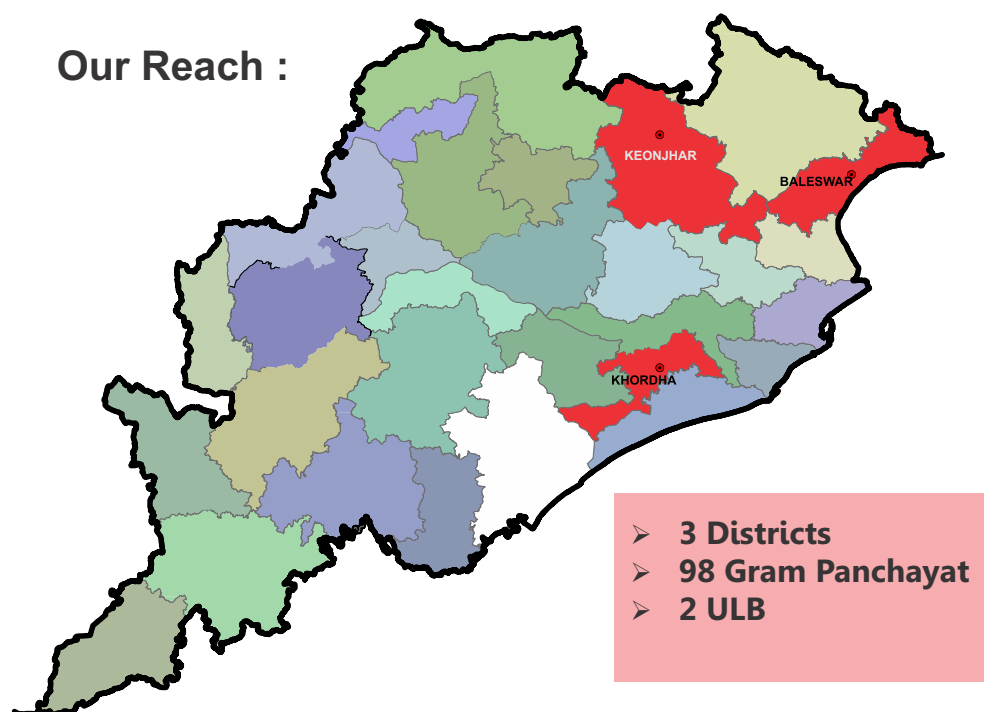
Background :

The Coronavirus pandemic has resulted in the death of at least 334675 individuals worldwide, with around 5.2 million cases being registered according to World Health Organization. In India, the number of people suffering from the virus has reached 118,501 having resulted in at least 3585 dead as on 22th of May, 2020 according to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

Odisha has total 1189 confirmed cases, out of which 393 have been cured and 7 deaths has occurred. At present Odisha have 789 active cases.

Operation Area: PECUC reach out to the community covering 98 Gram panchayat under 5 blocks and 4 urban slum in 3 districts (Khordha, Balasore, Keonjhar).

Our Reach :



PECUC'S Action At Community Level

Food and Nutrition :

Support to Migrant Labour: PECUC distributed Dry Ration to many crisis stricken Migrant labourers from outside state of West Bengal, Maharastra, Jharkhand and different districts of Odisha.

- 600 migrant labourers from different parts of the country provided dry ration for one month.
- Dry ration supported to 1888 families of daily wage labourers, migrant labourers, single women, older persons, disabled persons, left out etc.
- Supported 200 packets of biscuit and 200 water bottles to the children of BMC slum area.



Health :

The frontline health workers who are expected to deliver the services during this epidemic are also equally vulnerable while encountering numerous stakeholders in their daily duty. PECUC provided support for masks and gloves, use of sanitizers (PPE) by AWWs, ASHA workers and other service providers along with support hand to provide services in the community.



- **PECUC provided 4882 nos of masks to district and Block administration (Khordha, Balasore and Keonjhar District) and 700 gloves and sanitizer for Service providers (ASHA, AWW, Police, PDS work volunteers etc)**
- **Provided 500 Sanitary Napkin for adolescent girls to District Emergency Office and Khordha Municipality.**
- **Psycho-social counseling to 4500 HHs through telephonic interaction and door to door Meeting.**



WASH (Water, Sanitation &

WASH is an important sector closely linked to addressing the prevention of any disease outbreak including the COVID 19 disease. Special emphasis is given on hand washing along with the physical distancing and avoiding touching own face to prevent the virus from passing on through contact.

- PECUC conducted 255 community awareness campaigns/meetings through the volunteers with focus on hand wash. The Sisu Sava (child Right Club promoted by PECUC) members, ECOSAVERS youth Network group members are also played a great role to demonstrate and practice hand wash and awareness on other precautions.
- 6253 soap distributed 1888 house hold and 600 migrant labourers in Khordha and Keonjhar district.
- Distribution of IEC materials for corona prevention- 10000 leaflets distributed in the PECUC operational areas.
- Sharing information for maintaining safe physical distancing during PDS distribution, purchasing near market, drinking water collection, agricultural activity etc to various stakeholders.



Protection :

The scenario has raised anxieties, concerns and questions on the protection of vulnerable groups in the COVID-19 situation, the risks and threats that are faced by women, children and other vulnerable groups like people with disabilities.

- Children were encouraged to stay at home and take all precautionary measure to stay safe and fit during Lockdown Period.
- ECOSAVERS Youth Group Leaders gave video messages to aware people about the COVID19 situation and also spoke about all the protection measures prescribed by the Govt. and this message was widely shared in social media to reach many people.
- Continuous provision of telephonic counselling & door to door meeting and counselling to migrants, daily-wage workers, women, children, elderly and person with disability on govt. schemes & provisions.
- 44 days campaign to end child labour has been launched by PECUC and all the community based organisation (CBOs) are participating in this campaign and also keeping a close watch on safety of children.



Engagement of Children

- Children are vulnerable to all types of fear, panic, anxieties, mental stress during lockdown. Schools are closed and they are forced to stay at home due to lockdown announced by Govt., this is a challenge for parents, caregivers and stakeholders to deal with them in this critical juncture. PECUC is engaging children by involving them through various creative ways to lessen their mental stress.
- As many of the children are engaged themselves in online internet, they were counseled about online safety measures, they were taught to use and maintain the safety norms.
- They were provided support and guidance in their study.
- Children are engaged in a creative way. They are encouraged to participate in various activities like drawing, painting, short poem writing, poster making etc.
- The children during this lockdown period also observed the World Earth Day - They practiced hand wash by wearing mask, planted trees, wrote essays, paintings and poems etc. They strictly followed the safety norms while conducting the activities.
- During this crisis also the children group members continued the Friday for Future campaign to protect nature by planting trees, keeping water for animals and birds, creating bird nests, giving various messages through their paintings, drawings etc.
- Message by PECUC's Good Will Ambassadors: Bhoomika Dash, Eminent Cine Artist and PECUC's Goodwill ambassador for promotion of Child rights, and Anshika Routray, National Level sports person & PECUC Goodwill Ambassador for promotion of Right to Play, send their video message for the children by encouraging them to stay safe at home while engaging themselves in various creative ways.
- Message by Youth Group Leaders: The youth leaders through their messages described the situation of their respective villages and the awareness activities they are undertaking in this Lockdown situation.



Launching of 44 Days Campaign to End Child Labour: (From 30th April to 12th June)

- During this crisis period children are worst victim and susceptible to many form of violence. Among them child labour is the worst as it destroys the child hood. PECUC lunched like previous years this year too 44 Days campaign to end child labour to create awareness . This campaign was formally launched on 30th April and children engaged in many creative ways like wall painting, dance, writing slogan, poems etc to create awareness.
- Observation of National Anti Child Labour Day: On this day a Facebook Live programme "Say no to Child Labour" was organised by PECUC including many talented children including cine artist Bhoomika Dash, sports person Anshika Routray, child singer Abhijit Padhi, singer Punyata Dash, child musician Payoz Dash and eminent personalities like Ranjan Kumar Mohanty, Secretary PECUC, Legal Expert Prof. Prabir Kumar Pattnaik, Anuradha Biswal, Olympian, Jatin Dash, Senior Journalist and Anuradha Mohanty, Executive Director of PECUC & shared their views, opinion, presented song, etc to mark this occasion. Many inspiring short videos were shared to make people aware about the child labour situation.
- Quiz Competition: PECUC in association with Localwire is organising a quiz competition as a part of 44 days campaign to end child labour for 44 days. Both children and adult are participating in this competition daily.
- Poster Campaign: As a part of 44 days campaign poster campaign was also launched.
- This campaign is continuing and it will be concluded on 12th June on the occasion of World Day Against Child Labour.

Engagement with Government

- PECUC team is working in close coordination with state, district and Block administration to address the critical issues at community level. Also PECUC is closely working & supporting village & Panchayat level works.

Safety Measure of PECUC Staffs :

- PECUC staffs are maintaining all safety guidelines & taking precautions during the relief operation, awareness programme.
- Six advisory notes for response to Covid -19 pandemic shared with all staffs and volunteers across the organisation mentioning clearly the steps to be taken.
- The guideline & SOPs relating Covid-19 are strictly followed.

Convergence with schemes and Programme

PECUC team members are also identifying most vulnerable families who are facing problem. They are linking them in different scheme and programme of Govt. PECUC linking families in MGNREGA work in coordination with panchayat and block. PECUC provided support for income generation activities by producing mask with persons with disability and women groups.

Awareness Building

PECUC conducted awareness on COVID19 & more than 30000 people were aware about physical distancing and its importance, making white round circle in public places, market place, PDS Distribution Centre, drawing white circles in distribution points etc.

- Distribution of IEC materials for corona preventions – 10000 leaflets distributed in the PECUC operational areas.
- Social Media Campaign through PECUC Goodwill Ambassadors through WhatsApp Group, mail, LinkedIn, audio – video exchange for creating awareness on COVID19.

In this context , critical issues as follows :

- This lockdown has badly affected the vendors, small and marginalised farmers, single and old age women, person with disabilities, daily wage earners , daily wage earners , and most marginalised & vulnerable groups in the society, & children and women.
- Large number of migrant labours are coming from outside and it may create more demand of food and work.
- The daily wage labourers are struggling for two square of meals because of lock down.
- Children education also in stake, children are mentally stressed and they need more attention.

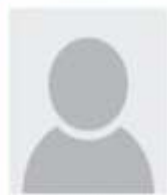

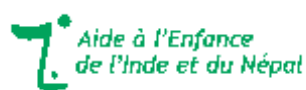
